## **\*\*Your Arrival Times:**

### **1st half of course**

**No later than 7:45 am**

(Assiniboine Park Dr./South Footbridge  
To Portage Ave/Douglas Park Rd)

### **2nd half of the course**

**No later than 8:15 am**

(Portage Av/Deer Lodge Place  
to Portage Ave/Lake)

*The route map:* under event details, course description.

*The volunteer map:* under the volunteer link, with the course marshal positions and aid stations marked.

## **\*\*Getting There:**

Volunteers are responsible for making their own way to their assigned post. You can do this on foot, by bike, by car ... be aware that access may be limited depending on which direction you are coming/going from. In the park, you may find room to park at the parking lots a little further from the start/finish area, while the area immediately around the start/finish is going to be very busy and not accessible.

## **\*\*Responsibilities:**

Course Marshalls are responsible for their assigned intersection as follows:

- Be visible to participants and traffic – please wear your race day course marshal pinny (if you get it). They can be left on site – left viability on the corner for pick up. You can also bring your pinny to the volunteer tent after the race.
- Ensure participants remain on the course and are running/walking in the right direction
- Ensure traffic stops to give participants the right of way
- Please remain at your post until the last participant of the event goes by (followed by a course cyclist).
- Emergencies: Please call 911. There are emergency vehicles on course - your call will be forwarded through the 911 system and the closest emergency vehicle will be dispatched.
- Cheer and create noise and to help motivate participants! Noise-makers and clappers welcome!
- Dress warmly, in layers. You may bring a chair or stool. Bring a beverage or a snack if you like.
- Washrooms: if you need to take a washroom break, you can leave you post to do so. Please check the website, under the volunteer link, for an update this coming week on the porto-pottie locations for this year.

**\*\*Thank you gift:** thank you gifts for the volunteers will be at race set up on Saturday, and at the race on Sunday at the volunteer/information tent. You are welcome to pick it up anytime its convenient.

**\*\*Pancake Breakfast:** for all volunteers. You are invited to stop by the food tent on your way to your intersection for coffee and some breakfast, or after the race.
